Built in Korea's traditional architectural style (Hanok), it offers a historical space to enjoy a snug and quaint atmosphere.

Ganghwa Gwangseongbo Fortress

#Mr. Sunshine

A battleground for the fiercest encounter during Shinmiyangyo in 1871, this site is fulfilling its role as a historical tour site following the 1976 renovations to the destroyed fortress. It is popular for students' field trips, seniors' tourist excursions, and visits by other groups interested in history and culture.

A model depicting modern architecture and the streets of Jung-gu, Incheon, during the 'Open Port' Period are exhibited in diorama form to illustrate the historical tales of the time and the modern architecture on display.

Songhyeon Neighborhood Park

When Songhyeon Reservoir was built to supply water in 1908, the site was called "Sudoguksan Mountain." By connecting Songhyeon Park and Songhyeon Reservoir Forest, it has become an eco-playground, now operated as a place for experiencing nature while listening to a guide's explanations of the forest.

O Sudoguksan Museum of Housing & Living



Sudoguksan Museum represents the old-time of Songrim-dong and Songhyeon-dong that were called "daldongne (Shantytown)". You can encounter recreated models of the times, such as a tiny store, a briquette store, a cotton - gin store, a barber shop, and dolls modeled after real workers from that era, such as the wastepaper picker and former store owners. This is a place where you can catch a glimpse of the lives of ordinary people in the 1960s and 1970s.

A restaurant serving Western food and specializing in pork cutlet, Yejeon is a hidden gem of Wolmido Island, offering a retro atmosphere that embodies Korean sentiment from the 1990s, backdropped by a view of the ocean.

This church was the first Anglican church in Korea. Its religious, historical, and architectural significance have earned its place as a Tangible Cultural Property of Incheon. Walking up the hill to the east of Hongyemun Gate, you can see the basilican church of granite in the style of the Middle Ages, coupled with traditional Korean eaves. Sitting on a bench under a tree here will put you in the perfect place for recovering your peace of mind.

This cafe was opened on Gaehang-ro by the incandescent lamp manufacturer Ilkwang Co. Ltd. Renovated from a former OB-GYN clinic building, the cafe retains an old-time retro atmosphere, while numerous incandescent lamps fill the space with warm light. The cafe is arranged with many photo zones and an operative machine for manufacturing incandescent lamps. Along with the cafe's specialty coffee and baked goods lamps made by Ilkwang are also on sale.



Taking on the theme of Bi-ryu's Baekje founding myth, Michuhol Park is a thematic neighborhood park that represents the historical symbolism of Michuhol Kingdom over an area of 160,099m². The major facilities include Gaetbeol Cultural Center, Daryewon, an artificial pond, an ox sculpture, 12 oriental zodiac animal statues, and walking trails. In Lake Park, many small fountains and a central fountain are arranged along with the beautiful waterside space filled with lotus flowers.
